The Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Theology of Development is an advanced research program that marries Evangelical theology with cutting-edge development scholarship. Doctoral seminars probe Scripture, Christian history, and theology alongside contemporary debates in sustainable development and social entrepreneurship. This interdisciplinary coursework equips candidates to forge a robust, biblically grounded framework for holistic transformation. Doctoral candidates cultivate high-level competencies in ethical research, leading to a dissertation that advances knowledge at the intersection of theology and development practice. Graduates emerge as scholar-practitioners and thought leaders ready to guide churches, NGOs, and other organizations toward Christ-centered solutions that yield lasting impact and faithfully advance the mission of the Gospel.

Our Educational Model: Flexibility and Empowerment

At IUDI, our fully online, asynchronous model allows you to study at your own pace from anywhere. With no fixed schedules or enrollment deadlines, you can start at any time and balance your studies with your personal, family, and professional responsibilities.

A Curriculum Designed for Leaders and Practitioners

We use a guided independent-learning approach within a flipped-classroom framework: students take responsibility for their own study under the guidance of faculty mentors rather than through traditional lectures.
